For eight weeks each summer, construction is done in many Appalachia communities in Kentucky, North Carolina, Tennessee, Virginia, and West Virginia. While ASP is only able to assist 1 out of every 10 families who apply, home repairs performed by ASP volunteers take place from the ground up to the roof and everywhere in-between. This bread pan money will help send 24 volunteers (4 work crews) to a county in the Appalachia Hollers of Kentucky.


