About Sardis:


- * 30 miles south of Thyatira
- * A city known for trade
- * Capital of Lydian kingdom
- * First to have gold and silver coins
- * Goddess were worshiped in this city- Artemis Dianna
- * Built on a hill with a fortress and it was built on top of the mountain (over 1,000-1,500 ft)











Revelation 3:1-6

To the angel (or Messenger) of the church in Ephesus

From: the words of him who has the seven spirits of God and the seven stars

What does Jesus ask of them? (v.2-3)

- 1. Wake up, and strengthen what remains and is on the point of death.
- 2. Remember then what you received and heard; obey it, and repent

Consequences (v.3b)

If you do not wake up, I will come like a thief, and you will not know at what hour I will come to you.

Matthew 24:42-44

- ⁴² Therefore, stay awake, for you do not know on what day your Lord is coming.
- ⁴³ But know this, that if the master of the house had known in what part of the night the thief was coming, he would have stayed awake and would not have let his house be broken into.
- ⁴⁴ Therefore you also must be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect.

⁴ Yet you have still a few persons in Sardis who have not soiled their clothes; they will walk with me, dressed in white, for they are worthy.

If you conquer, (v.5-6)

- 1. Clothed like them in white robes
- 2. Will not blot your name out of the Book of Life
- 3. Will confess your name before my Father and before his angels.
