## John 12:12

The next day the great crowd that had come to the festival heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem.



## John 12:13

**<sup>13</sup> So they took branches of palm trees and went out to meet him, shouting, “Hosanna! Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the Lord— the King of Israel!”**



## Zechariah 9:9

Rejoice greatly, O daughter Zion! Shout aloud,  
O daughter Jerusalem! Lo, your king comes to  
you; triumphant and victorious is he, humble  
and riding on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a  
donkey.



## John 12:14-15

Jesus found a young donkey and sat on it;  
as it is written:

15 “Do not be afraid, daughter of Zion.  
Look, your king is coming, sitting on a  
donkey’s colt!”



**John 12:16**

**His disciples did not understand these things at first; but when Jesus was glorified, then they remembered that these things had been written of him and had been done to him.**



## John 12:19

**<sup>19</sup> The Pharisees then said to one another,  
“You see, you can do nothing. Look, the world  
has gone after him!”**

**\*Lord's Supper- washes disciples' feet; Judas departs**

**\*To Garden of Gethsemane; Jesus' agony**

**\*Betrayal by Judas; arrest by Sanhedrin**

**\*To the house of High Priest Peter denies Jesus**



## **Friday:**

Matt. 27:50, John 19:30; Matt. 27:58-60

**\* Jesus was before the Council-** the assembly of the elders of the people

**\* Jesus was sent to Pilate**

**\* Pilate sent Jesus to Herod**

**\* Herod with his soldiers mocked Jesus and returned Jesus to Pilate**





## **John 19:1-2**

**Then Pilate took Jesus and had him flogged. <sup>2</sup> And the soldiers wove a crown of thorns and put it on his head, and they dressed him in a purple robe.**





## **John 19:3-4**

**<sup>3</sup> They kept coming up to him, saying, “Hail, King of the Jews!” and striking him on the face.**

**<sup>4</sup> Pilate went out again and said to them, “Look, I am bringing him out to you to let you know that I find no case against him.”**





## **John 19:5**

**<sup>5</sup> So Jesus came out, wearing the crown of thorns and the purple robe. Pilate said to them, “Here is the man!”**





## John 19:6

**<sup>6</sup> When the chief priests and the police saw him, they shouted, “Crucify him! Crucify him!” Pilate said to them, “Take him yourselves and crucify him; I find no case against him.”**





**John 19:19-20b**

**Pilate also had an inscription written and put on the cross. It read,**

**“Jesus of Nazareth, the King of the Jews.”**

**... it was written in Hebrew, in Latin, and in Greek.**
