Seven Churches

1. Ephesus:

Restore first love. Repent, and do the works they did first.

2. Smyrna:

Do not fear and be faithful until death.



3. Pergamum:

Repent, Do not compromise

4. Thyatira:

Repent for tolerating



5. Sardis:

Wake up and strengthen what remains and is on the point of death.

6. Philadelphia:

Hold fast to what you have, so that no one may seize your crown.

20 Listen! I am standing at the door, knocking; if you hear my voice and open the door, I will come in to you and eat with you, and you with me.




