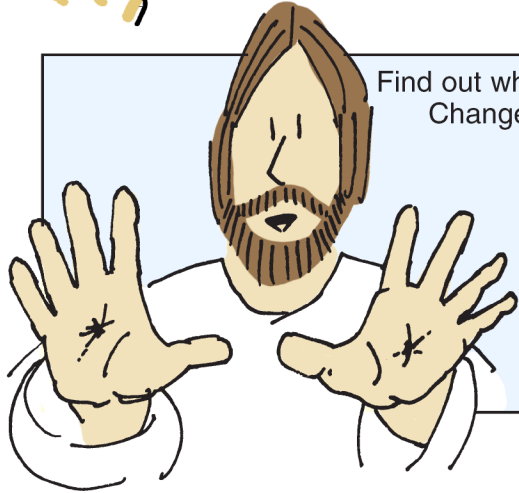


Thomas was not with the other disciples when Jesus appeared to them. He doubted what they told him. He needed to see the nail marks to know it was Jesus.

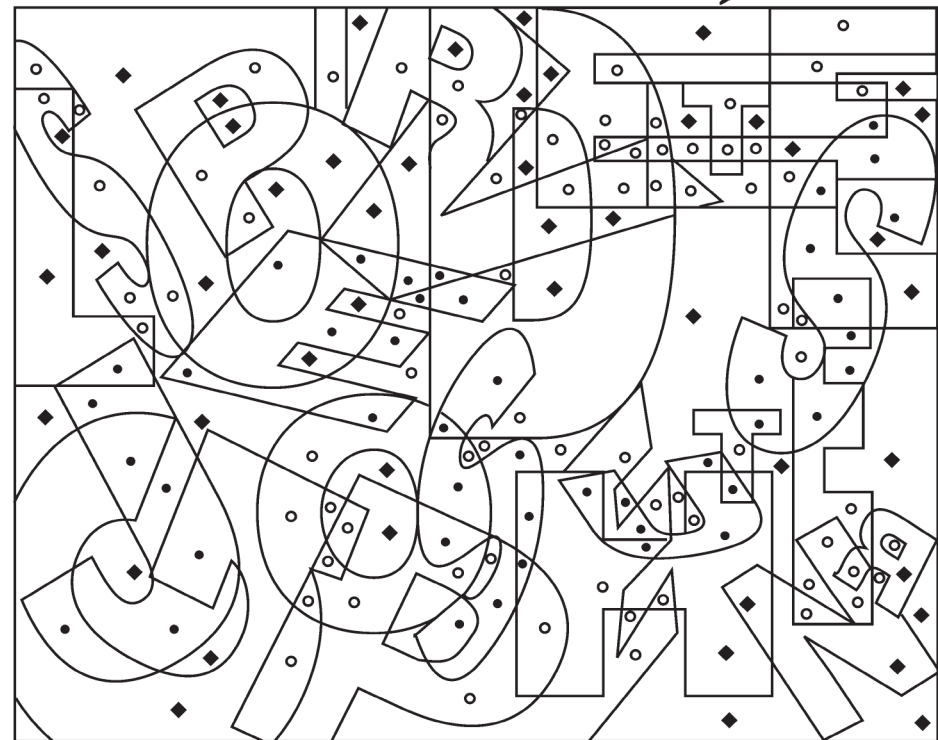
