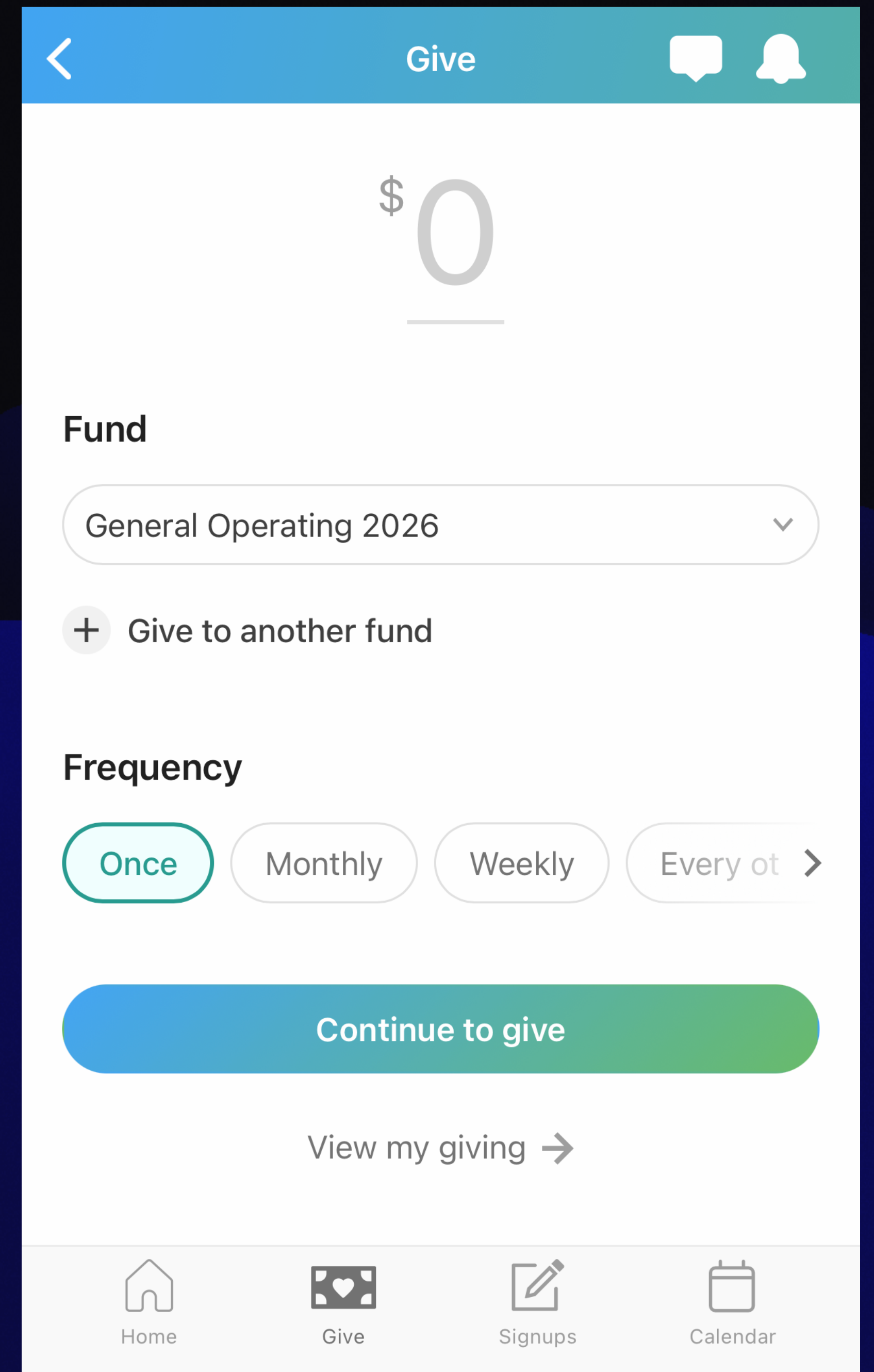






What do thief and bandits do?
